DOUBLE CHECK THAT YOU HAVE ALL ITEMS FROM THIS LIST

ITEMS TO BRING

- ***BIBLE**, with optional pen/paper if you want to take notes
- ***Pillow, blanket or sleeping bag**
- ***Hygiene items** - **deodorant, soap/shampoo, toothbrush/toothpaste, towel, garbage bag for dirty clothes, other needed hygiene items** ***optional sunscreen, insect repellent

CLOTHES

- ***Clothes for sleeping**
- ***Athletic/Casual clothes for 4 days - bring extras**

- ***TOWELS (bathing and for activities)**

**Shorts should be loose fitting and knee length*

**No leggings, tights, yoga pants without shorts overtop of them*

**No sleeveless shirts/tops*

**No torn pants/shorts where the tears are above your knees*

**No clothing or hats that promote non-Christian musicians or sinful behavior*

CONFERENCE CLOTHES

 - >Young men will change into church service-appropriate pants and shoes (no tie)
 - >Young ladies will change into church service-appropriate skirts
- *You do not need to wear service clothes for the bus ride, you will have opportunity to change clothes before service

>YOUNG LADIES - loose fitting, knee length skirts/dresses for 4 days.

**slits in skirts must not go above your knee*

>YOUNG MEN- khaki or any non-denim pants, nice shoes, and button down shirt with tie for 4 days

**No jeans for the services - we are asking everyone to "dress up"*

MONDAY
